**Leading Stocks Post Gains At Montreal**

MONTREAL, April 29—(CP)—Leading stocks posted gains ranging from fractions to more than a point while in balance of list pluses and minuses were evenly distributed on the stock exchange and curb market today. Trading was only moderately active with total volume considerably lower than yesterday.

Canadian Breweries was a feature among the more heavily traded issues and advanced 1 3/4 at 24 3/4. Dryden added 1-8 at 19 5/4 and Tobacco Preferred the same amount at 7 7/8. Nickel converted a slip into a gain of 1-8 at 35. Consolidated bonded back to the win column, up 1-8 at 16, after earlier touching a new low at 15 5/8.

Seagrams, St. Lawrence Corporation and United Steel closed unchanged after minor fluctuations.

National Breweries was up two points, Bell and St. Lawrence Paper Pfd, 1 each and National Steel Car 1-2. Southmount added two cents at 41. Tobacco Common gained 3-8 and B. C. Forest 1-4. International Paper and Imperial Oil erased losses and finished with small fractional increases. Abitibi Pfd, Bank of Montreal and Brien were steady.

Smelters, down 1 1-8 and Dominion Textiles, off 1 1-8, were among more prominent losers. Hudson Bay gave up 1-2. Denco 'B' 1-4 and Abitibi Common, Shawinigan and C. W. Lumber 1-8.

**Sharp Sell-off On N. Y. Exchange Reversed At Close**

NEW YORK, April 29—(AP)—A brief but sharp sell-off hit the stock market around noon today but support soon arrived and losses of fractions to 2 or more points were reduced or converted into advances at the close.

The liquidating flurry, which converged on virtually all departments, followed the reiteration by President Truman of his plea to business for price cuts as a means of averting an inflation depression cycle. Later buying, largely by professionals, was credited to the idea that a technical comeback was in the offing.

The Associated Press 60-stock composite was unchanged at 61.4 due to the presence of a number of key stocks in the advancing division of the index.

Distillers Seagram, closing up 1/4 after early easiness, stood out among Canadian issues. Canadian Pacific, easy in early trading, added 1-8 at the close. McIntyre was off 1/4 and Dome Mines eased 1-8. On the curb, Lake Shore eased 1-8.

Gainers of around a point included Eastman Kodak at 230 (on a pleasing sales compilation); Illinois Central at 22 1/4; Texas Co. at 50; J. C. Penny at 41, and U.S. Gypsum at 97 1/2.

American Telephone was unchanged at 165 1/2, as the stalemate continued in the communications strike.
