ANCHORS CLINCH CITY LEAGUE BASEBALL CHAMPIONSHIP

A Hectic Struggle To The Ninth When The Stars Blew Up A Howling The Anchors To Double The Score For A Win Of 12 To 6. His Honor Lt. Governor Hartz Presents Trophies To Hoyt Of The Anchors And Lynds Of The Stars Also A Purse Of \$100 To Umpire Jack McAleer From The City League Teams And Fans.

Saturday afternoon at the Abegweit grounds under ideal weather conditions for baseball, FINIS was written in capital letters to the City League Baseball, when the Anchors and Stars met on the Diamond in the last and deciding game for the City League Baseball Championship.

The game developed into a hectic struggle from the start until the ninth innings when the Stars blew up and allowed the Anchors to run off with the game, the Penant and the Silverware by a score of 12 to 6.

Without a doubt the largest turnout of spectators this season crowded the bleachers to witness both teams battle for supremacy and they received real value for their money for at no time was the game won up to the ninth.

There was always enough of hits, catches, close decisions, errors and scores even to keep the most ardent fan in suspense.

It was a grand day for the West Section of the City and every fan, small and large went away from the grounds happy and smiling and with that feeling "I told you so."

The Stars put up a hard fight but the Anchors kept hammering them away until the Stars gave away under the pressure and the ninth found them floundering helplessly until the last out, but the game was then won.

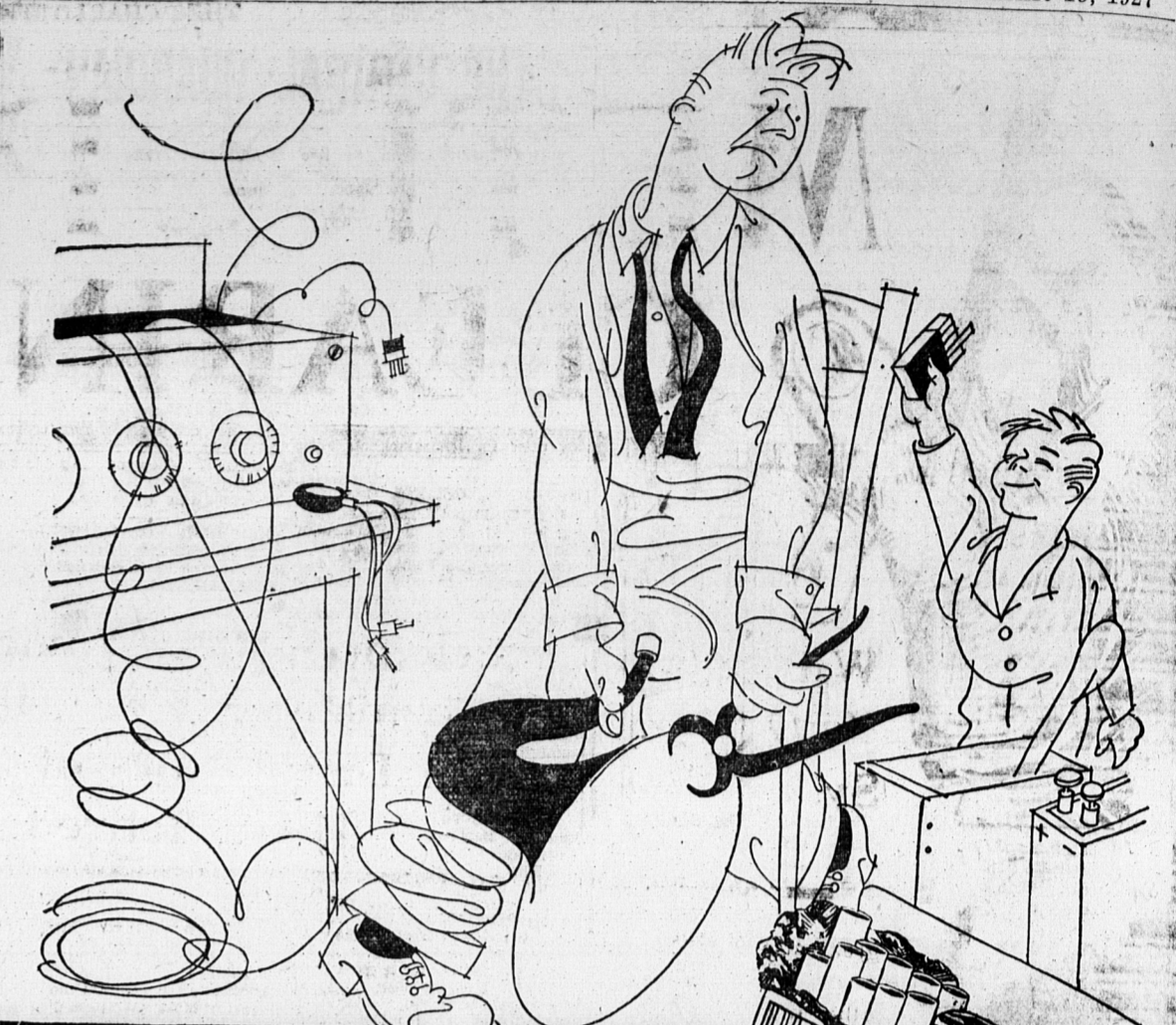
Both players and fans were keyed right up to the highest pitch and it looked more like the Big League Pennant Race games than the play-off for the City League title, and it was Big League stuff to the City League fans, they were more interested and the players kept the game up by that constant labor that makes or breaks the best.

The Anchors deserve every credit for coming from behind like they did to win the Second Section and then go out and win the play-off. They were playing ball all the way, but to Hoyt goes the most credit for his brilliant head work as much as anything responsible for Saturday's win. He was ably backed up by the whole team especially by D. Diamond, Saunders, Cronin, S. Diamond and McGuigan. The Stars under the able leadership of Dr. Douglas, went through the first section without a defeat and came within an ace of winning the Second Section, winning the first game of the play-off and were booked to retain the honors for another year, but the Anchors came about upsetting the dome by catching the tables completely on the Stars and then came back strong to trim them out for the championship.

McFarlane, working on the mound for the Anchors showed tip top form and particularly effective in the pinches and surely proved himself a wonder.

The Anchors were surely meeting McQuaid's offering, having five two baggers during the game, to two by the Stars.
