—ISLAND FOXES FOR SCOTLAND—Mr. John Murray of Linkletter left on Saturday afternoon for Montreal, where he will leave on the S. S. Montcalm for Glasgow, Scotland. Mr. Murray is taking a shipment of live foxes to Mr. Geddes of Melrose, Scotland, who is starting a ranch there. Mr. Murray will return with Mr. Geddes for about twelve months to look after the ranch and advise Mr. Geddes on the successful ranching of the silver fox. In the shipment are blue foxes and black racoons from Ontario. There are also some silver foxes from prize winning foxes from the ranch of Mr. A. E. McLean, M. P., who is accompanying Mr. Murray as far as Montreal.—S.

—COUNTY COURT AT SUMMERSIDE—The October term of the County Court commenced at Summerside on Friday, Judge Inman presiding. Fifty-five summonses had been issued but the contested cases, numbered ten. His Honor gave a lengthy written judgment in the case of Firth Bowness vs William Clark, tried last August term for an action for money due on a sale of a pair of silver black foxes. He found a verdict for the plaintiff for \$125.00 and costs. Lowell Compton and Heath Strong, K.C., for Plaintiff and Ernest H. Strong, K.C., for defendant. The case of the Home School Education Society vs Ivan Brown of Kensington was then tried. This was an action for \$89.50 being amount claimed for 10 volumes of the Source Book and Extension service. Defence was that the Book was full of errors and was not as represented and that same had been returned to company. The Plaintiff alleged that the books contained errors such as "New York state contains the financial centre of the world, New York City," "Spain sold Florida to the United States in 1921 for five million dollars," "after election in Ontario in 1926 Government Control was in force in Canada from coast to coast." Rev. E. H. Ramsay, of Trinity United Church was examined on part of defence. He had purchased a set and it wasn't what he expected.
