DEMONSTRATION FARMS

OTTAWA, Aug. 9.—Three farms have been chosen in Nova Scotia by the commission of conservation for purposes of demonstrating and illustrating to surrounding farmers of the province as to how the best can be obtained from the land with the least possible depreciation to the richness of the soil. The owners of these farms in each case have declared their readiness to be guided by the agricultural experts of the commission, Messrs. Nunnick and Pixter, who will arrange to hold meetings of farmers from time to time, at which economic methods of farming will be demonstrated, and successful farmers will speak on various phases of agriculture. It is to be noted, however, that these farms are not acquired by purchase or lease by the commission, but are merely offered for illustration purposes by the owners, who continue to operate them. Eight farms have been chosen in Ontario, six in Quebec, and three each in the maritime provinces. Nova Scotia's chosen farms for the purpose are as follows:—Annapolis county, farm of V. B. Leonard, Clarence Centre; Antigonish county, farm of Taylor Bros, Antigonish, P. O.; Pictou county, farm of H. M. Tattler, River John P. O.

THE PANAMA TOLLS

WASHINGTON, Aug. 8.—The extent to which the Canadian Pacific Railway might control traffic through the Panama Canal gave the Senate occasion for much debate when the anti-railroad section of the Canal Bill was reached late today.

It will not be necessary for Secretary Knox to advise the British Government of the action taken by Congress in exempting American vessels from paying tolls on the Panama Canal, unless Great Britain chooses to make specific inquiry on that point. It is scarcely expected that it will do so, satisfying itself by taking notice of the proceedings in Congress.

Although there has been no formal statement of the views of the Administration in regard to the matter of tolls, for American shipping since the pending Canal Bill was reported from the House Committee on Inter-oceanic Canals, it may safely be inferred that there has been no change in their position since in public speeches President Taft and Secretary Stimson both asserted the right of the United States to remit the tolls or grant rebates on American ships. Students of the situation point out that Great Britain could reduce the tolls of the Suez Canal a great share of the prospective business of the Panama Canal, and cause considerable financial loss to the Panama Canal.

NEW GOLF RECORD.

TORONTO, August 8.—In the first round of the Canadian open golf championship played this morning in drizzling rain at Rosedale, George Sargent, of Cheyve Chase, the national golf champion of the United States, put up a new record for the course by putting in a card of 72 for the round.

TO IDENTIFY MURDERERS.

NEW YORK, August 8.—Cumulative evidence piling up before the grand jury investigating the police blackmail, is said today to involve four of five high officials and that indictments will soon be drawn. Witnesses examined by District Attorney Whitman to the confession of "Bald Jack" Rose, who gave a list of names of gamblers upon whom he charged Police Lieutenant Becker levied blackmail.

The several gamblers were before the public prosecutor and unwillingly admitted that they had paid blackmail to certain inspectors. One of the witnesses told Mr. Whitman that he had been threatened with death if he went before the grand jury and gave information about the police. These witnesses said that these inspectors deal direct with the gamblers would be presented to the grand jury against several police inspectors. One of these inspectors is said to have kept such close watch on the gambling houses that he even examined the books and made them pay blackmail according to their profits.

Bridg Webber now admits that he also collected toll from certain uptown gambling houses for a police inspector. Webber's life has been threatened, and District Attorney Whitman has provided him with a special guard. "Bald Jack" Rose has sent word to the public prosecutor that he is prepared to identify four murderers of Rosenthal. Until now Rose was not ready to say that he could positively identify the gun men.

CHEAP FARES TO TORONTO EXHIBITION.

In connection with the Canadian National Exhibition at Toronto which will be held this year from August 24th until September 9th, the Intercolonial Railway will give very low excursion rates which will give the opportunity to many to visit the "Queen City" on the occasion of its great annual fête.

From Charlottetown the round trip fare will be \$25.75 good going August 22, 24, 25, 27, 28 and September 4 and 5. A special rate of \$19.85 will prevail on August 23 and 29, and on September 3rd. Maritime Province travellers will have their choice of two through vestibule trains, the Ocean Limited and the Maritime Express, both of which connect at Bonaventure Union Station, Montreal, with the through Grand Trunk Railway trains for Toronto.
