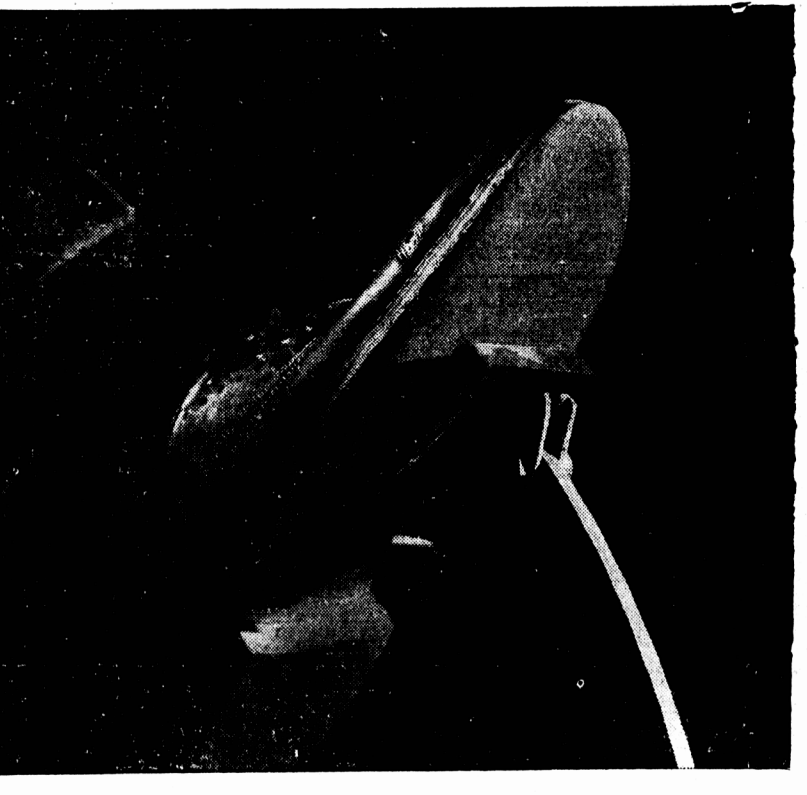


Mr. Haken was born and educated in England, and entered the advertising profession in 1920.
