## THE LEGISLATURE

### YESTERDAY

The Leaders Pay Tributes to the Late Speaker Hon. Matthew Smith.

March 2.  
The Legislative Assembly met under sad and unique circumstances at 12:15 o'clock. The Speaker's chair was vacant; his desk and the canopy above were draped in black. A solemn stillness prevailed the Chamber. The

PREMIER HASZARD, in tones of suppressed emotion rose in his place and addressing the Clerk, said it became his sad duty to report to the House the death of Honorable Matthew Smith, Speaker of that body, which sad event had occurred yesterday afternoon. It must be a source of great sadness that the hand of death had removed from them the head of the House. He had occupied the Speaker's chair for only a few weeks, but had been a member of the House for a much longer time. They had all come to know, respect and honor him, and all must feel the great loss they had sustained. Mr. Smith was one of the most genial and kindly of men, and also most honest, straightforward and unassuming. They could all bear witness to the fairness and impartiality with which he had discharged the duties of his high office. If he had erred at any time or in any way they must feel that it was an error of the head and not of the heart. No man could be more anxious to discharge his duty with strict impartiality. The loss caused by his removal from the House and from life's activities must be great to them all. To himself it brought a sense of personal bereavement. Deeper far was the loss to his wife and

## FOOT AND MOUTH DISEASE IN U. S.

WASHINGTON, March 1.—The federal quarantine on account of foot and mouth disease has been further modified by the Secretary of Agriculture, effective today, and the quarantine is hereby reduced to include only the particular townships in which the disease existed, together with certain adjoining townships. New York, Michigan, and Maryland other than the area mentioned are released entirely from the federal quarantine. This modification has no practical effect on export shipments to Great Britain, as the British quarantine against these states remain in full force.

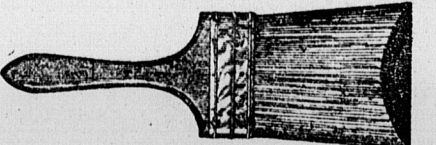
