WHAT MEN VOTE FOR.

Aside from those who are strong party men and who always vote for the party candidate, the quality which win the support of individual voters are many and various.

There are other electors, not many perhaps, whose dislikes are stronger than their likings, who will vote for Smith, not because they have any good will for him, or for his party, or policy, but solely because they have a repugnance for Brown, who is running on the opposite side.

Character is sometimes lightly estimated as a qualification for a seat in Parliament, even by men who pride themselves upon their own personal rectitude and integrity.

The fact is that the ideal politicians and statesmen are few and far between. A little girl once asked her mother why it is that the wicked people are the nicest?

Then, as to honesty among public men in the matter of handling the people's money. Most of us are, like Hamlet, "indifferent honest" ourselves.

But how many are ready with an excuse for the man who gets a raise-off in the matter of a public contract, or as a middleman in the purchase of land or supplies for a public department, or in some other way gets a little more from the public treasury than is properly coming to him.

"The worship of success attained by whatever means not too openly immoral, is very widespread. 'Men will praise thee when thou doest well to thyself,'" wrote Solomon, and the truth of the saying was not confined to his day.

Every voter has a standard of his

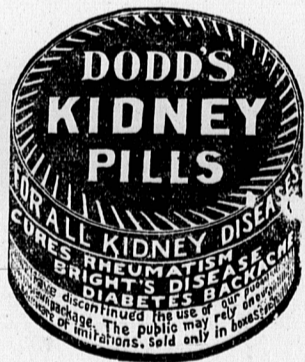
own by which to judge of the candidate. The estimate is not made by points, as we judge competing cattle. Probably if a scale were to be drawn up by each elector the average voter would allot seventy five of the one hundred points to party, twenty of the remaining twenty five to the chance of winning the election and about five points for character.

Some day in the dim and distant future we shall reduce politics to a science, educate all our young men in the duties and responsibilities of citizenship and train the brightest and best of them for public life as carefully, and with as severe tests of fitness, honor and capacity to be passed as are now required for the highest of the learned professions.

In the coming provincial elections temperance electors should be very careful not to mark their ballots for any candidate whose influence, if elected, would go to weaken the Prohibitory Law or its enforcement.

What is there distinctively Liberal in the policy of one party, or distinctively Conservative in the policy of the other in the present election contest? Are not the party names, after all, mere party tags, as Dr. Macphail stated in a letter to The Guardian the other day?

In our civic affairs, happily kept pretty clear of politics, extensive public improvements in the way of a sewerage system, improved streets, and new permanent sidewalks have been laid down without even the suspicion of waste or graft.
