Schools to have teachers qualified there. To encourage teachers to attend such schools, a bonus of \$30 a year is given to such teachers as quality. These two things, viz., increase of salary and provision to have teachers better qualified, might be considered apart from party exigencies, and could be acted on by the Legislature before the close of the

present session if the members would. As this communication is already too long for a newspaper article I shall leave notice of other matters to a future article.
