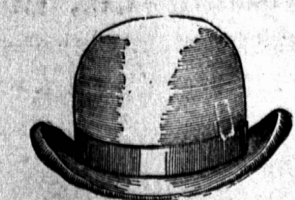

C.P.R. STEAMER BREAKS RECORDS

MONTREAL, June 15—The C.P.R. royal mail steamer "Empress of Britain" sailing from the landing stage at Liverpool, at six o'clock Saturday evening June 9th, passed to sea from Moville at nine o'clock Sunday morning. She was in communication with Cape Race by Marconi wireless telegraph at six o'clock this morning, being at that time one hundred miles east of that station, thus completing the run from land to land in three days and twenty-one hours. This not only beats her own record but the record of any other steamship over the same route. A westerly gale is reported at Cape Race which may delay her advance up the river. The steamer is expected in Quebec early Saturday morning. She carries 107 first-class, 412 second-class and 350 third-class passengers.
