Eastern Guardian Wage Cut Affects 1,000,000

NEW YORK, Nov. 11.—Immediate action is to be taken to secure the reduction of wages for train and yard service employees, approximating to 10 per cent. on all lines north of Ohio and the Potomac rivers and east of Mississippi was announced today following a meeting of the presidents of the lines involved. The reductions, according to L. F. Loree, President of the Delaware and Hudson railway, will be in line with the decision reached by railroad executives in Chicago on Oct. 14. Wage cuts will affect approximately 1,000,000 men.

For Eugenic Reasons French Chamber Asked to Amend Divorce Laws

PARIS, Nov. 11.—A proposal has been made in the French Chamber entailing the alteration of divorce laws. It is being examined by the legislative commission. At present, although it is possible to obtain divorce in France on the grounds of incompatibility of temper, a similar dissolution of marriage cannot be decreed by a court on such a serious ground as morbidity, which may physically affect the other party, or even the health of children. It is generally felt that while the community has little interest in the dissolution of marriages on more or less trivial, futile or even merely temporary grounds, there is every reason to facilitate separation in cases which may well affect the future of the race. Therefore, it seems is every likelihood an amendment to the present laws will be accepted by the commission and voted by Parliament.

Record Heartbeat or Breathing Sound

WASHINGTON, Nov. 14.—Perfection of a device which will record the sound of a human breath or a heart beat on a steel wire from which they can be accurately reproduced at any time, is announced by the Bureau of Standards. The work was undertaken at the request of the Army Medical Service, as permanent records of unusual conditions of heart and

lungs were desired for clinical instruction. The device comprises use of an ordinary telephone transmitter and a stethoscope, it is explained, the current generated by the heat of the heart being amplified and connected with a steel wire telegraphophone which has the different sounds impressed upon its spool of wire in the form of varying degrees of magnetization.
