money lender sues to recover money which he has lent, or for the enforcement of any new agreement or security, and the court is satisfied "that the interest charged is excessive or that the amount charged for expenses, inquiries, fines, or bonus premium, renewals, are excessive," or that the transaction is "harsh and unconscionable," the Court may re-open the transaction and take an account between the parties, and set aside, revise, or alter any security given or agreement made. In the face of such direct legislative encouragement, the judges are not likely to hesitate much longer. On the other hand, it must be remembered that the English law contains a golden principle to the effect that same men should be able to enter into (and accordingly be bound by) whatever business contracts they choose to make. It was Archbishop Magee who once said that he would rather see England free than England sober, and the same spirit may induce the judges to continue to allow a creditor to recover his cent. per cent.

If the money-lender has parted with a security, for value, the Court can order him to indemnify the borrower. Borrowers may also begin proceedings against money-lenders, even though the time for the repayment of the loan or any installment has not arrived. And where money-lender is a creditor in bankruptcy proceedings, the bankruptcy judge may exercise all of these powers. These provisions apply to every transaction which is "substantially one of money-lending by a money-lender," no matter what its superficial guise may be. It is evident from this brief outline that an important but unostentatious addition to the statute law has come into operation, and it is to be hoped that it will have the effect of making usury very difficult and risky, if not actually impossible.

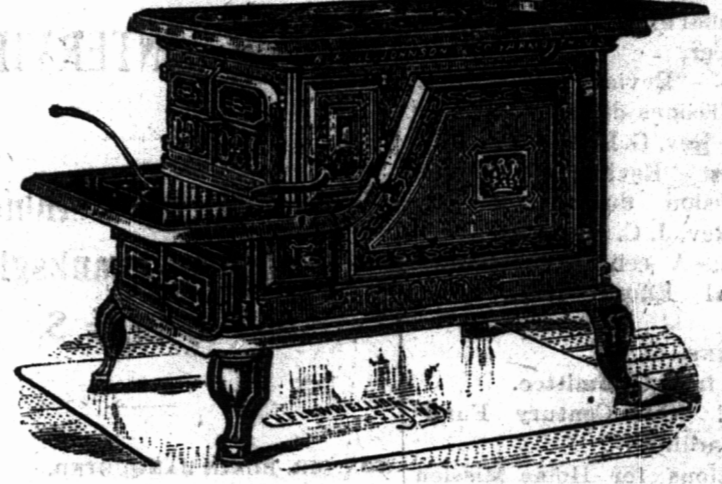

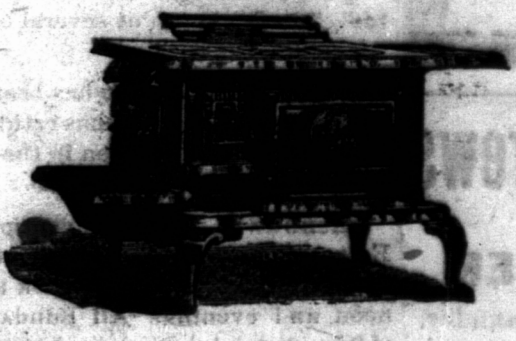

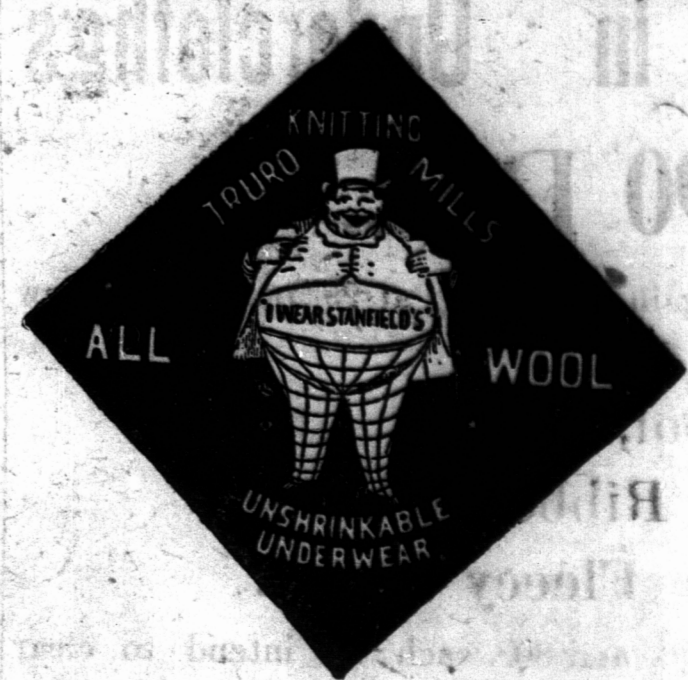
