TORREY LASHES NEWPORT VICE IN HIS SERMON

The Evangelist Tells the Chicagoans they Have a Better City

CHICAGO, November 27.—"The conditions of things at Newport are rotten enough to put South Clark street, Chicago to shame," said Evangelist Torrey in a sermon in the Windy City.

This was the climax of a talk in which he bitterly arraigned society and social conditions everywhere.

"Socially, the world is deteriorating," said he. "Financial and social morals are at the lowest ebb. The real conditions in high society in the East and West alike put the vice of Chicago's levee to blush."

THE PROPOSED RUSSIA-NEW YORK RAILWAY LINE

The Appeal for Railroad Rates Has Been Opposed by Oil Men

ST. PETERSBURG, Nov. 27.—There has developed here a powerful lobby against the petition of the managers of the Russian Volunteer Fleet for special railroad tariffs to Libau in order to facilitate direct trade to New York. 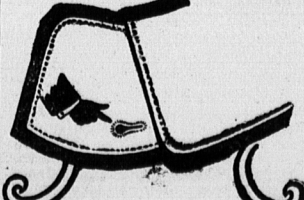
