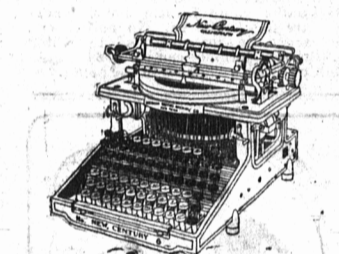

THE EXPEDITION TO THIBET.

Col. Younghusband's expedition into Thibet, with the object of establishing diplomatic relations at the capital of that shy people is meeting with increasing and stubborn opposition.

An uneasy feeling has grown up owing to the determined and resisted resistance of the Thibetans, the courage and devotion with which they sacrifice their lives and the fact of their possessing better arms than they were believed to have.
