HINTS FOR The Motorist

WRONG VOLTAGE

W. S. writes: My car has a six-volt electrical equipment but the battery is no good. A friend of mine has a 12-volt battery which he will give me. Will it be all right to use it?



Answer: You cannot use it to take the place of your battery until making changes in it, as it would burn out your lamps at once, your generator could not charge it and it would not deliver current enough to work your starter motor.

ONE HEADLIGHT REFUSES TO BURN. R. J. asks: How many ground wires are there in the electric system of the car? I think that it must have a short-circuit as I can get only one of the headlights to burn.

Answer: In the wiring diagram no ground wires are shown, the lighting system being grounded at the junction box, the generator being grounded through its frame and the battery being grounded through the starter-motor frame.

TREATING TARNISHED LAMP REFLECTIONS. R. W. G. asks: Is there any preparation for removing the tarnish from lamp reflectors? Where can they be retarnished if this becomes necessary?

Answer: First try wiping the reflecting surfaces off with a small ball of absorbent cotton, moistened in alcohol and then if necessary, apply a little high grade silver polish and rub it gently with a very soft chamolite leather until the luster has been restored as far as possible.

WHAT ENGINE PARTS NEED LUBRICATION. Before describing the several systems of engine lubrication, it is desirable to enumerate the various points about an engine which require oiling.

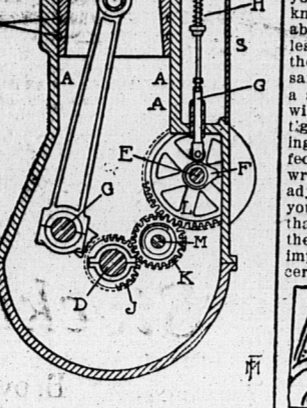

G. is a valve-operating a pushrod with a roller upon its lower end, through which up and down motion is communicated to it by the cam F. G. slides in a guide, fixed in the crank-case wall and these surfaces require oil as do the surfaces of the cam, the roller, and the pin on which the roller turns.

ANOTHER CASE OF KNOCKING. W. V. writes: My engine has a knock that is heard plainly when the car is running on the level or down grade, but hardly at all when it is pulling up hill.

Answer: Generally speaking, the knock from a loose crankshaft is especially noticeable when the engine is pulling hard on a hill and not when it is running and it seems hardly likely that the knock in your engine is a main bearing.



PREVENTING RUST IN COOLING SYSTEM. R. B. asks: Can you tell me of anything to use in the water system of a new car to prevent the formation of rust in it?

Answer: We have not tried any of this compound, but we have no reason to believe that the claims made for it are unfounded.
