

# Historic Windsor Is Background For Royal Pictures



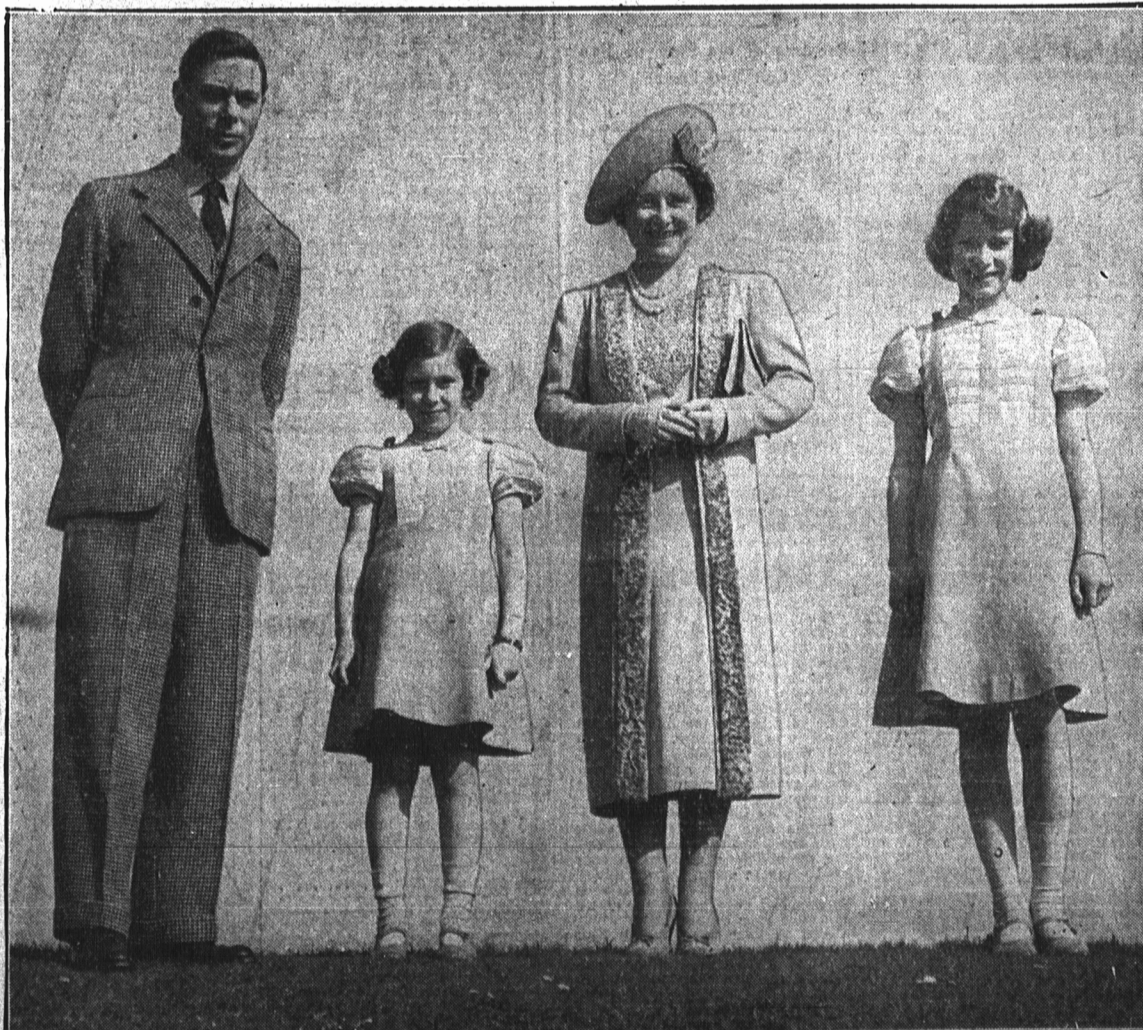

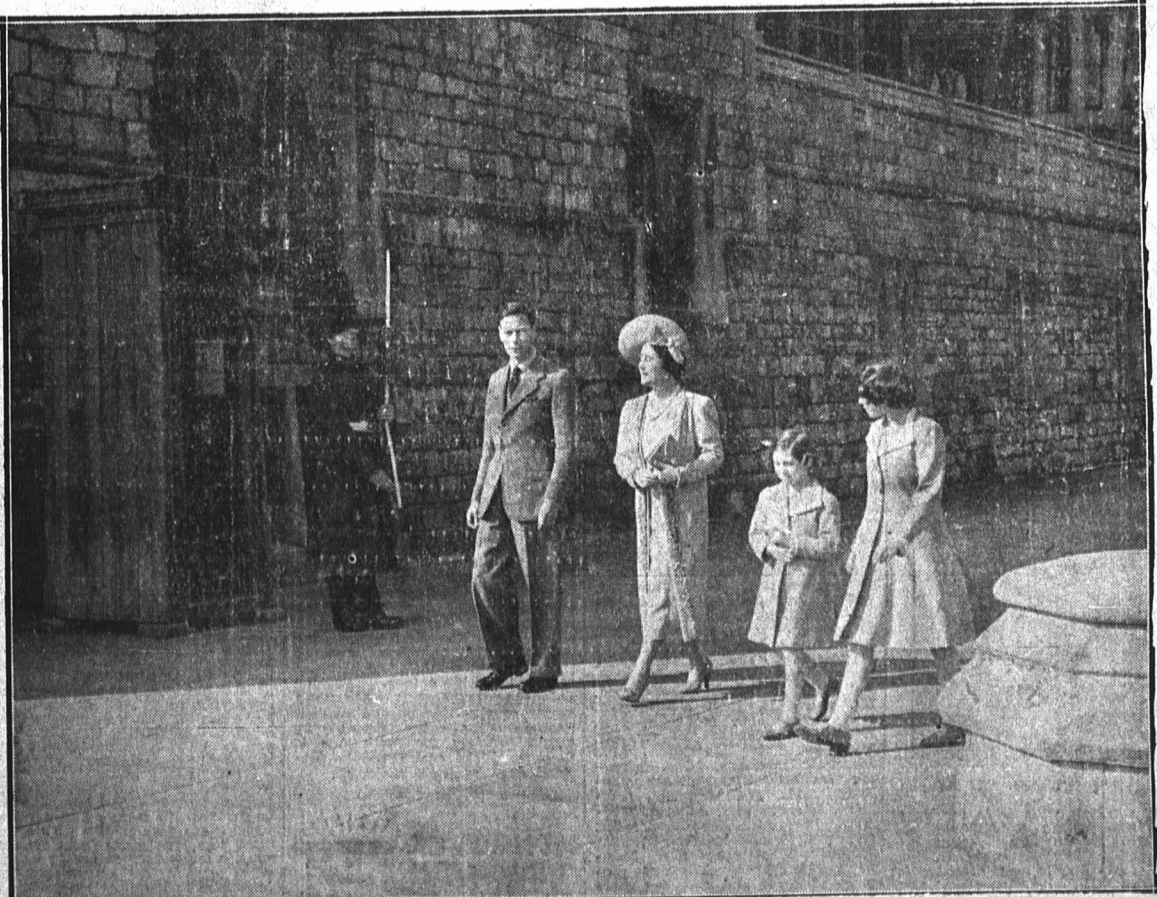
