Poisoned Bait To Kill Mice

Poisons are generally quite effective against mice and in cases of serious and prolonged infestations the use of tree protection by putting out poisoned bait. It is recommended to use one part of white arsenic to three parts of cornmeal. Mix this dry thoroughly and place about a teaspoonful in each can.
