Contract Bridge

Weak defense on both sides of the table was responsible for the success of today's contract.

The bidding: South West North East 3NT Pass Pass Pass

North's two club take-out was a bit too strong for his holding - one notrump would have been sounder. West could find no better opening than the heart jack. East put up the ace and though he considered shifting to diamonds, decided that he had better return his partner's lead.

Declarer, in with the heart king led the club six and when West played the five, put in dummy's eight-spot. East jumped on this trick with the jack and now shifted to his fourth-highest diamond.

Declarer went right on with the ace and led his last club. The appearance of West's king must have been extremely soothing to declarer, who now could run four club tricks. There with two spades, two hearts and one diamond, nicely rounded with the contract.

As mentioned previously, both West and East fell down in their defense. With the possible entry in dummy outside of the club suit itself, West should have gone right in with the club king on the first lead of that suit, as the best of all ways to "kill" the suit.

However, even though West missed his opportunity, East should have made a rescue play. He should have returned the ace upon first club trick with the jack. The club king was marked in West's hand, and by holding up the jack, East would at least reduce the declarer's club winners from four to three tricks.
