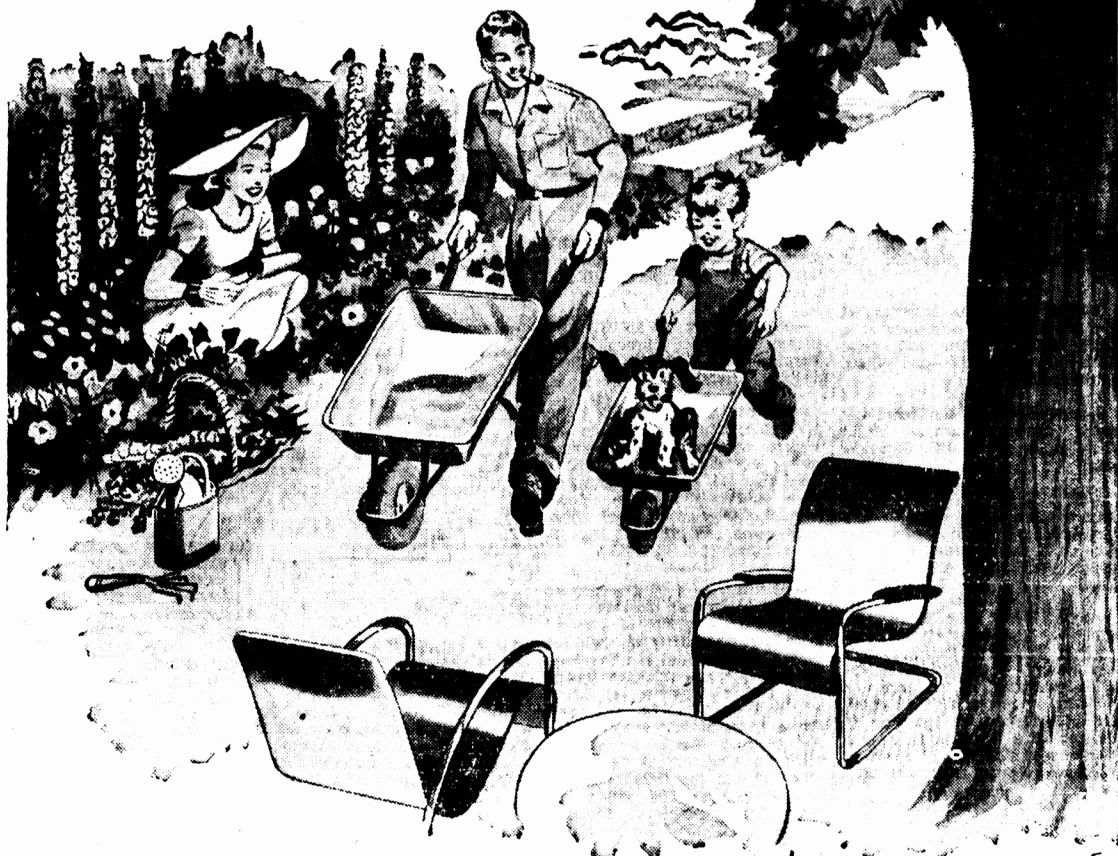

POTATO GROWER'S SPRAY BULLETIN

The first brood of potato flea beetles is now about over. The second brood will appear during the second week of August. Aphids and tarnished plant bugs are just beginning to appear in many fields. DDT should be applied at regular intervals throughout the season to keep these insects under control.
