MR. T. ANDREW BUTLER

The death of T. Andrew Butler occurred at his home, 15 Pownall Street, on Wednesday, August 18. The late Mr. Butler was a son of Thomas Butler and Elizabeth Carmody. He was born on November 12th, 1886, and lived all his life in Charlottetown. He had been in failing health for the past four months but his last illness was short and death came unexpectedly.

He leaves to mourn his wife, formerly Maude Callaghan, five sons and two daughters, namely: Rev. Thomas P. St. Peter's Bay; Frank C. N.
