WHAT TO DO WITH THE STOCK FARM

The Opinions Expressed by Farmers' Institutes on This Important Question.

At the meeting called for the election of delegates to attend the Convention in Charlottetown on January 15th, 1906 each Farmers' Institute was requested to discuss the following propositions and report to the Department of Agriculture their preference not later than January 15th, 1906.

PROPOSITION NO. 1.

Whether or not the Government Stock Farm should be continued or disposed of.

If retained, then the establishment of a Model Dairy Farm and Experiment Station, erection of suitable buildings, establishment of an up-to-date dairy herd and a small herd of beef cattle for demonstration purposes—or

Proposition No. 2 was adopted by the unanimous vote at the Farmers' Institute Convention held in Charlottetown in April, 1905.

CARDIGAN INSTITUTES.

"At the annual meeting of Cardigan Institute held 28th inst. (December) proposal No. 2, to keep Experimental Farm with herds for breeding purposes only was adopted."

"Proposition No. 3 was also adopted by the unanimous vote of our Institute."

CENTRAL INSTITUTE.

"On the question of the Stock Farm after an animated discussion a Resolution almost identical to the one passed by the Convention in April last was read and passed by the meeting."

EXCELSIOR INSTITUTE.

"The regular meeting of the Excelsior Institute, the question of the Government Farm was discussed and the following Resolution unanimously agreed to, Resolved that in the opinion of this meeting, the Government Farm should not be disposed of but kept as a stock farm. That short-horn and Ayrshire cattle should be kept, two of the best breeds of pigs also sheep; Also Resolved that this stock be procured from the Old Country as far as possible; Also Resolved that no part of the Farm be used for experimental work unless Dominion Government bears the expense, and that experimental work be kept separate from other Department; Also Resolved that surplus stock be sold at the Provincial Exhibition each year."

DUNDAS INSTITUTE.
