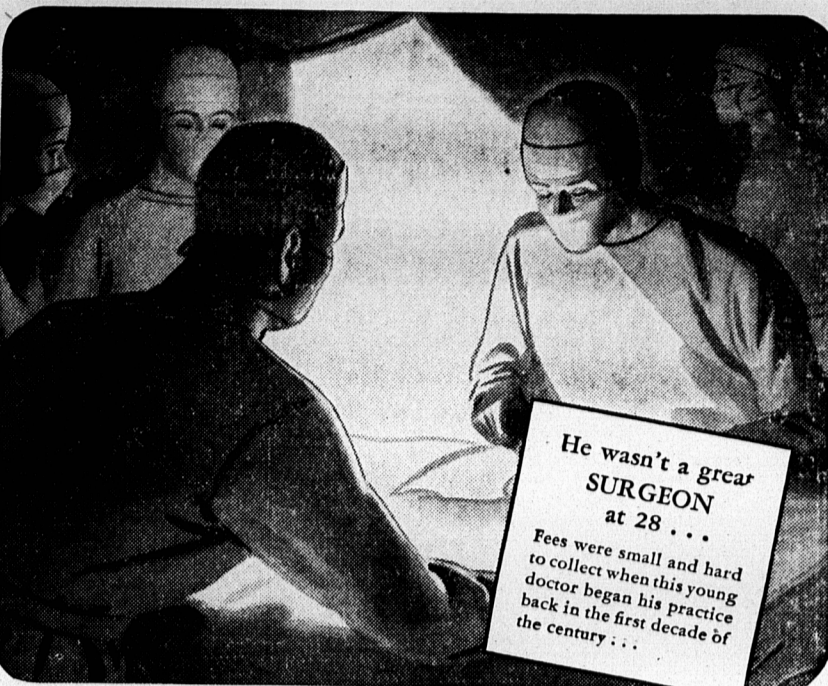

ATTENTION STALLION OWNERS

According to the provisions of the Stallion Enrolment Act, all stallions two years old and over standing for service in the Province of Prince Edward Island must be enrolled in the records of the Department of Agriculture. The cost of enrolment is two dollars and this amount must accompany application. Each application should include the name of horse, breed, age, colour, description, names of sire and dam, and registration number, if horse is registered. All horses standing for service must be inspected by an accredited inspector appointed by the Provincial Department of Agriculture and carry a grading certificate. Stallion owners are asked to enrol their animals immediately so that arrangements for any necessary inspection may be made at the earliest possible moment. Inspection service will be conducted early in May. Owners who use horses for service that have not been enrolled or have not been inspected will be subject to the penalty provided by the Stallion Enrolment Act. Only horses enrolled and graded within the required grades of this Act will be permitted to travel for public service. Horses not graded within required grades may offer at owner's stables only. Horses inspected for the first time in 1939 and thereafter and not meeting required grades will not be permitted to travel or stand for service.
