VIENNA, June 25--In well informed quarters here it is considered probable that King Otto of Bavaria, will soon be deposed. When Prince Regent Luitpold was in Vienna recently, he took part in a discussion in court circles as to the advisability of ending the absurdity of Bavaria being ruled in the name of an insane sovereign and of the Viennese court commencing this view to the Bavarian Government.

COACHMAN OF QUEEN VICTORIA

LONDON, June 25--Sandé, Queen Victoria's coachman, who drove her for more than forty years, and without whom she would not go out in a carriage, may be seen daily upon the streets of Windsor, and if you can warm him up a little he will relate anecdotes of the late queen by the hour. He is retired on a pension of \$750 and has been given a little cottage on the royal estates at Eton to live in. Sandé never drove anybody but the queen, and was subject to her orders absolutely. For forty years he has never mounted a box unless she was in the carriage, and it was probably true as stated that she never rode unless he held the reins. Although she was very stout, Queen Victoria was in the habit of riding horseback up to a few years before her death. Even when she was more than seventy-five years of age she frequently mounted the saddle, with the faithful Sandé at her side, and rode slowly around the riding hall at Windsor, or among the paths upon the palace grounds. She considered it the best form of exercise.

LONDON, June 25--Lieut. Tulloch, who accompanied the Royal Society's commission to Uganda to investigate the "sleeping sickness" which disease he contracted while dissecting an inoculated rat, died Wednesday in London of the sickness.
