Mexico Rejects Barter "Deal"

MEXICO CITY, Feb. 23—Ambas-
sador Joseph Daniels of the
United States announced today
Mexico has turned down a propo-
sed trade of oil for 17 German
commercial planes.
The Ambassador was reported
authoritatively to have expressed
displeasure to the Mexican Gov-
ernment over the proposed barter
with its possible military ramifica-
tions, since the planes were of a
type which could be converted into
a fighter.
A factor in Daniels' favor is his
reported objection that Mexican
Army aviators preferred North
American planes, due to the avail-
ability of replacement and parts
and the fact that many of the
pilots were trained in the United
States.

NEW YORK, Feb. 24 (AP)—The Netherlands Guilder tumbled 10 of a cent in terms of the United States dollar today to the lowest price since October, 1932. The latest decline capped a series of breaks that started in early January.
The pound sterling and French franc set a record in the other direction as moderate advances swung both units to the top for the year thus far. The pound advanced 1/4 of a cent, higher at \$4.89 1-8 and the franc 00 1-16 of a cent up at 265. Canadian funds firmed 7/64 to a discount of 11-32.
The Beiga was unchanged and the Swiss Franc narrowly down.
