MAKE-UP POSES PROBLEM Summer evenings which are flooded with daylight until some- were around 9 o'clock call for make-up rules that are quite different from those employed during winter months when it got dark long before the dinner hour.

The make-up that will be soft, subtle and slight after some when the lights are turned on will seem garish and hard when you leave your house in the daylight at seven. However, the make-up that is smart at seven will, in artificial light, have a washed-out look about it.

The trick, then, is to apply street make-up when you dress for dinner. Dress in a supply of rouge and mascara and cold cream as you get lipstick. When it begins to get dark and the lights are turned on, go to the powder room and apply mascara and put on more rouge. Be sure that the rouge you carry with you is the same shade as that you used at home. Otherwise there'll be streaks and queer shadows on your cheeks.

Got a frock you're sick of the sight of? Well, remember that two-color schemes are smart steel your heart and take a pair of scissors in your hand. Cut away the entire front part of the bodice and replace it with contrast material. (Your work-basket or pressbag may help you out—if you must buy, it won't be an expensive item.) A boat-shaped neckline and gathered shoulders are simple enough for anyone to tackle.

Here is a recipe for Irish potato bread, brown as fudge, the advantage of which is that it requires no fat in the making. It is delicious served hot with butter, or if fried in bacon fat it makes a very little bacon go a long way.

Scrub some potatoes, boil them in their skins, then peel and mash smoothly. When cool enough to handle add a little salt and sufficient sieved flour to make a pliable dough. Knead the dough for five minutes or so on a well-floured pastry board, then roll into a large round 1-4 in. thick. Cut into eighths or more slices and cook on a hot griddle until brown then turn and brown the other side.
