JAPAN IS PEACEFUL.

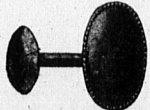
Since the Anti-Japanese rioting in San Francisco in September last there has been much talk of war between the United States and Japan. This has no been confined to the American press, but has more or less occupied the attention of the great journals of the civilized world. It has led to the requisition by the Washington War Department for \$38,400,000 for fortifications and other military works, mainly for the Philippines. Long range guns, submarine mines and torpedo planters for the eastern possessions of the Republic and for Hawaii and Cuba are included. Mainly from the same cause, has come about the movement of the United States battleship fleet to the Pacific Ocean with every ship as well equipped for fighting as if war had been actually declared. It would be most deplorable should actual war result, but this there is little reason to fear. Japan is the close ally of Great Britain, and should hostilities break out between Britain's ally and the United States it might be impossible to limit the struggle to the two powers which hereafter are to be naval rivals on the Pacific. But Japan does not want war. She is yet burdened with the heavy debt rolled up in her gigantic controversy with Russia. Britain, as a close friend of both parties and King Edward as the world's Peace-maker may be counted upon to use every effort to prevent a hostile encounter. In the meantime it is assuring to find Japan in the face of apparent war preparations by the United States, cutting down by a hundred millions or more her yearly outlay for military and naval purposes. Thus Japan gives the best possible assurance of her peaceful intentions.

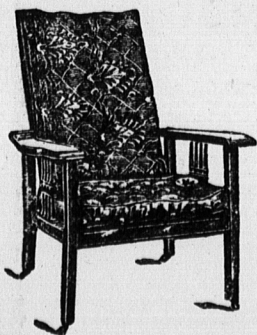
