Decline In Stock Market Prices Continued Yesterday

NEW YORK, Jan. 25.—(AP)—The stock market declined for the second day in a row today after reaching a high since early November on Saturday. Losses of fractions to around 2 points gave the market its largest overall setback in some 10 days. Trading broadened to include 1,013 issues, also a 10-day top. Market operations were affected considerably by a meeting of directors of U. S. Steel Corp., results of which were not divulged until after the close of the market. Big steel common stock is a market pivot and the meeting was preceded by the usual round of rumors concerning possible dividend or other action affecting the stock. U. S. Steel's \$1 special dividend and stock split-up have been rumored off and on in the financial district. Steel Common closed at 72 7/8, down 3/4, after losing more than a point at one time. Monday the stock advanced 1 1/2 points in the face of a declining market. Turnover was comparatively slow throughout and about on a par with recent sessions. Sales of \$60,000 shares compared with \$80,000 Monday.

At Toronto

TORONTO, Jan. 25.—(CP)—Selling pressure threw all groups for a loss in the Toronto Stock Exchange today. Junior goods were an almost one-way downward movement. Base metals and western oils sagged slightly in the moderate activity. Base metals weakened from yesterday's strong upsurge. International Nickel, Quemet and Noranda dipped fractionally while Pend Oreille and Reeves MacDon-ald, yesterday's features, lost 10 and five cents respectively. Waco Amulet was up 1/8 but weakened towards the close to finish un-changed. Losses almost tripled gains in golds. Seniors were mixed and a wide list of juniors showed losses ranging up to 10 cents.
