Proof of "Sixth Sense" is Established

NEW YORK, Sept. 24.—Definite scientific proof supporting the age-old belief that man has telephatic power—can project his thoughts, even great distances, into other minds—was claimed today by Dr. Alexis Carrel, noted research scientist after experiments at h's Rockefeller Institute laboratories.

The exact nature of his experiments, he said he will reveal soon, in a monograph on which he now is working. But the research indicated, he said, that everybody has some degree of the weird power to direct thoughts through space, and also powers of clairvoyance, the ability to see into the future. In some, the "sixth sense" is highly developed, in others almost entirely dormant.

Dr. Carrel's monograph will follow his book, "Man the Unknown." This urges creation of an institute, where all scientific fields studying man, be correlated to produce super-men, the objective being superior intellect.

His interest in man's "sixth sense," seen in connection with his work on man, indicated that he believed mental faculties latent in men today, will be usual to science's visualized "super-men."

"But this question is not of importance," he said. "Telepathy is just a part of the whole. What we need to do to improve man is to realize that we can modify the nature, as well as the organs, of the mind." Dr. Carrel doubted that the Nazis' German program of race purification would be of value to the human race.

"It may be that crossing civilizations as we do in America produces the finest minds," he said. "We do not know the genesis of great men. Perhaps it would be effective if we can kill off the worst of these pure races and keep the best, as we do in breeding dogs."

Development of high mentality, he held, was more important than finding the secret of longevity, which science does not yet know, he added, but might be able sooner to know in the kind of institute he suggests.

The scientist was somewhat disposed to retire women to the home world. Asked what he would do in the case of many women of achievement in the arts and sciences, he replied: "I don't infer an inferiority on the part of women; only women bear children and men do not. We frankly can not have a human race unless this can be recognized."

Once Bitter Enemies Meet "Bury Hatchet"

LOS ANGELES, Sept. 24.—A deep hatred, born in 1892, was forgotten yesterday when Emmett Dalton and Charles Gump met. May be the names don't mean much to the present generation but they were once in the news.

The scene is Coffeyville, Kas. and the date is October 5, 1892. The Dalton gang, one of the most notorious outlaw gangs of the Old West, galloped into town, walked into the bank, fronting the town square and started their robbery. Ten minutes later, four of the Dalton gang were dead—Bob and Grat Dalton, Dick Broadwell and Bill Powers.

Emmett Dalton, youngest member of the gang, lay in the street badly wounded. He recovered and was sent to prison for 15 years. It was Charles Gump who sounded the death knell for the Dalton gang. He witnessed their arrival, sounded the alarm and mobilized the townsmen.

They met Wednesday night—both gray-haired and not so quick on the trigger finger any more—and shook hands. "Time is a great healer," they said.

They plan a reunion again on October 5, the anniversary of one of the bloodiest street battles in the West.
