Stock Markets End Week In Quiet Sessions

NEW YORK, Feb. 20—(AP)—A skittish stock market took the longest stride ahead last week in a month. The outlook of the financial district brightened a bit last week and around \$900,000,000 was added to the market value of all stocks listed on the exchange. Toward the week-end the market settled back for a breathing spell after a sprint ahead on Thursday. Losses on Friday and Saturday slightly outweighed gains.

At Toronto

TORONTO, Feb. 20—(CP)—Dull trading Saturday made little overall change in Toronto stock exchange prices. Base metals were mixed, few western oils appeared and golds showed a majority of minus signs. The exchange's index showed golds down .11 at 96.63, base metals down .12 at 101.44 and western oils up .20 at 52.28. Volume was 345,000 shares.

At Montreal

MONTREAL, Feb. 20—(CP)—Scattered fractional declines ruled in quiet dealings during Saturday's two-hour session on the Montreal stock exchange and curb market, despite a steady to slightly improved undertone noted among the leaders. Penny losses outnumbered gains seven to one in mines. The bulk of trading was centred on selected industrials throughout the week and the majority of issues continued to work steadily into lower ground.
