(Continued from Page 1) White House emphasized the fact that the President must await the passage of a measure by Congress to enable him to arrange bilateral trade pacts.

The United States also plans to make agreements with various other countries. During the Imperial Economic Conference most of the treaties were framed along similar lines, though the details as to tariff preferences were different.

Some of the United States newspapers are stating that Canada is offering the Republic the crumbs after giving the trade loaf to British countries, but the experts are said to be inclined to the view that the big obstacles to better trade relations between the country and Canada are outside the Ottawa agreements altogether.

An amendment passed by the Senate today on the Farm Bill, which would give the President power to inflate the currency and which may be used to bring the money of the two countries more on a level, might work as more of a boon than any change in tariffs. It is a great experiment, but as the senator expressed it, the nation desires drastic action.
