CHICAGO, March 11 — (AP) — Grain markets rallied after early easiness yesterday then turned quiet as traders retired to the sidelines to await week-end developments.

TORONTO, March 11 — (CP) — The mining groups registered a moderate recovery in Saturday's session of the Toronto Exchange and the other groups finished the day with small index losses.

MONTREAL, March 11 — (CP) — All key groups completed trading last week on the Stock Exchange and Curb Market at lower ranges compared with the previous week-end.

NEW YORK, March 11 — (AP) — The Stock Market finished a sharply reactionary week Saturday with recovery tendencies appearing in almost all departments.

KENNECOTT, Northern Ireland — (CP) — Nine German prisoners-of-war who escaped from an internment camp here were recaptured four days later only a few miles away.

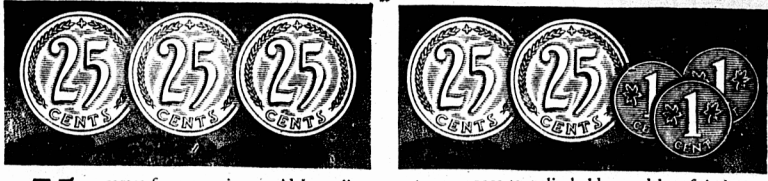

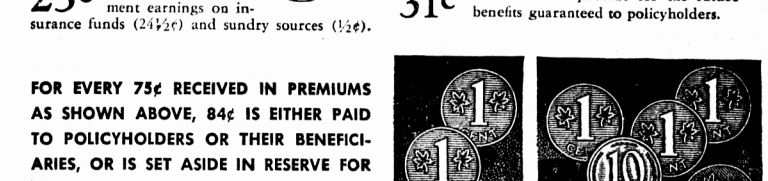
