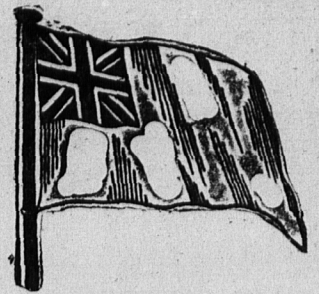


# We'll Never Let the Old FLAG Fall!!
