Hornsby Replies in Suit for \$92,000

ST. LOUIS, Mo., May 21.-Rogers Hornsby, captain of the New York Giants and manager last year of the World championship Cardinals baseball team, today filed his reply in Clayton Circuit Court to the suit brought against him last February by Frank L. Moore, Louisville bookmaker, for alleged indebtedness of \$92,000.

Hornsby seeks to have the suit set aside, alleging that ten of eleven transactions named by Moore were in the nature of gambling and not admissible at law.

MONTREAL, May 21.-"Red" MacDonald, of Halifax, was suspended by the Athletic Commission of Montreal today for his failure to make weight and fulfill his engagement with Freddie Tilston, of Winnipeg, in semi-finals of the lightweight elimination tournament here Wednesday night, last. His deposit of \$100, as guarantee to make weight, was paid to Promoter Arm and Vincent. The suspension imposed was for an indefinite period.
