FROM the East, The Guardian's correspondent writes: The prevailing wind for the month has been strong northeast, seriously interfering with the lobster catch on the north side, and rendering its financial success doubtful. On the south side weather conditions have been more favorable and there was a good catch of cod-fish, and a fair catch of lobsters. Considerable quantities of mackerel are also netted, and as a large proportion appears to have escaped the purses seines of Gloucester, on their way to the Gulf, our fishermen hope to catch some with the hook later on. There is one drawback to our net fishermen here and which they think could be easily remedied, viz: the destruction of their nets by the steamers of the Magdalen route. Last season the ill fated S. S. Lunenburg left Souris very late after dark and appeared to deliberately hug the shore in the zone of the mackerel nets. Off Basin Head alone the loss of eight nets was laid to her charge, not only the loss of the net but the loss of the catch for the season, an item of considerable importance to our hard worked fishermen. A few days ago the S. S. Amelia turned in towards the shore off Basin Head on a bright morning with a man on the bridge, probably with good eyesight and deliberately or inadvertently destroyed a mackerel net of a well known citizen, the morning being too stormy to take it up. While fishermen willingly recognize the freedom of the ocean highway, they think they have rights also which should be respected in their anxious and important calling, and that the steamers have a moral if not a legal obligation to make the circle of their course from Souris to East Point a trifle larger to escape all dangers of contact with their nets.
