EXCITEMENT IN BRITISH PARLIAMENT.

The Fight Over the Education Bill Will be a Stubborn one. Even Sir William Vernon Harcourt Was Freely Called to Order.

LONDON, Oct. 18.—The temperature has not fallen in parliament. Even so experienced a debater as Sir William Harcourt was repeatedly called to order yesterday in committee on questions of relevancy and was finally rebuked by the chairman.

Party feeling is running high at Westminster, with each bench accusing the other of deliberate misrepresentation and Premier Balfour declining to define the character and scope of the control which will be exercised over the denominational schools.

LIBERAL PARTY UNITED. The liberal party is united at last on a fighting issue, faction feuds are forgotten and Lord Rosebery's speech has brought the leaguers and imperialists into line with the most unmanageable radicals.
