EXCELSIOR INSTITUTE REGULAR MEETING.

Excelsior Institute, York, held a meeting on the 26th Feb'y which was well attended. After some routine business was transacted T. P. Cullen (who was at last meeting appointed to give an address on how to improve our educational system) so the boys and girls would retain more interest in the Homestead farm.) then took the floor. After he has shown that the system prevailing in this province does not meet the requirements of today but must be changed to meet the needs of the times. That the boys must be kept interested in farming till they get set (so to say) in their ideas. He concluded with the following resolution: That whereas the present system of Education as practised does not meet fully the requirements of our Island:

Therefore resolved that we the members of Excelsior Institute ask the Legislature to open Juvenile Institutes in as many sections as possible, ages of students to be from 15 years upwards, students to be taught by district teachers in the theory of agriculture book-keeping and said Institutes to be self-sustaining. Considerable discussion followed, and it was made plain that an arrangement along this line would go a long way to keep the boys interested in agriculture.

It was also plain that although teachers get small salaries yet for the hours they work they do not fare so badly, but that by the organization of Juvenile Institutes, taxing students \$3 to \$5 per head said ten to go to teacher, teaching say three or more evenings each week commencing as soon as day school closes. This would add to teachers salary and make them interested in getting as many students as possible. T. P. Cullen and P. Brodie were appointed to wait on the Government and present resolution for establishing Central Institute. Go Crockett and Bruce Dick were appointed to attend school-fair at Summerside.

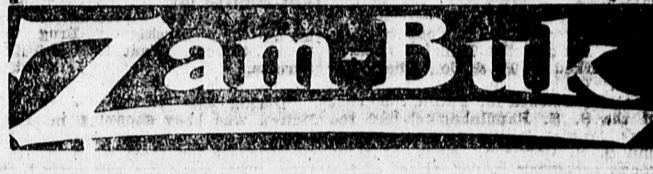
