### BRITAIN HAS 3,896 PICTURE THEATRES

LONDON, March 23.—There are 3,896 motion picture theatres in Great Britain as compared with 3,878 in Germany. London has 755 such theatres, the largest number in any city in the British Isles, as compared with Berlin's total of 342 cinemas.

Manchester, with 475 moving picture houses, ranks second to London in the number of cinemas, while Leeds is third, with 465 theatres. It is of interest to note that in the latter city there are three cinemas with seating capacity between 2,500 and 3,000 persons, while in London there are only two houses of that size. Birmingham also has two motion picture theatres that will seat an audience of 3,000.
