CYPHER SYSTEM.

For Domestic Telegraphing and Calling

H. L. Hunt, of N. Y., is in this city in the interest of the Western Union telegraphic code—the most complete code ever produced. The Western Union code having been placed in the offices of the Western Union, the Anglo-American and Great North Western Telegraph Companies and in the offices of the Direct United States Cable Co., and other companies throughout the world, enables any holder of it to telegraph to any individual without considering whether his correspondence is supplied with the code. If the receiver of the message has not a code he gets his translation through the office of the company. The saying by the use of the code is from six to fourteen words for one, which naturally makes it of value to anyone whose telegraphic expenses reach to four dollars a month or over. Another advantage to the subscriber lies in the fact that any person desiring to wire him may have the use of the code at the office of the several companies by simply requesting it. All subscribers' names are registered in a directory of telegraphic and cable addresses which is bound with the code. They appear alphabetically, classified under city and provincial headings, and also under appropriate business headings:—A general cable address accompanies the name in both instances. This saves those who do business abroad the annual expense of registering a cable address in countries where a charge is levied for such registration. The next edition of the code will appear in December with a guaranteed circulation of 100,000 copies, and as the name of each subscriber appears in each copy, he gets incidentally considerable advertising at home and abroad. The code contains about 150,000 code words and phrases and has been officially adopted by the Dominion government, United States government, cities of Montreal and Toronto, banks throughout Canada, including Bank of Montreal, Molson's Bank, Merchants Bank of Canada, and by nearly every one of the largest commercial enterprises on this and other continents.
