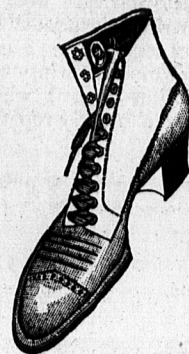

## THE RESTLESS UTE INDIANS ON WARPAT AGAIN

Uncle Sam's Troops 100 Miles Away Get a Hurry Call

WASHINGTON, Oct. 26.—The tribe of Ute Indians which more than a year ago wandered away from their reservation in Utah and created trouble in Colorado and Wyoming by threatening to take the war path and raid ranches, is reported to have again broken out on the Cheyenne river reservation in South Dakota, where the tribe was given temporary quarters.

At the request of the secretary of the Interior, the war department today ordered troops from Fort Meade (S.D.) to the scene of the trouble.
