EGG LAYING CONTEST

Notes on The Fifth P. E. I. Egg Laying Contest For The 48th Week Ending Oct. 2nd, 1923.

Production is gradually declining as the P. E. I. Egg Laying Contest is nearing a finish only four weeks remaining. The total production for the week amounted to 567 compared with 657 of the previous week a drop of 90 eggs. The total production to date is 30,359. A large number of the Leghorns are heavy in moult.

Welsh District Bans English Doctor

(By Dominion News Service)

CARDIFF, Oct. 5—The question whether or not an Englishman is a fit person to be medical officer of the Abersoch district of Carnarvonshire, caused acute controversy at a meeting of Pwllheli Guardians. Dr. Edon, an Englishman, was the only applicant, and Mr. Richard Thomas, Abersoch, proposed to advertise for a Welsh doctor, as most of the inhabitants could not understand English. The Chairman: There are English applicants for every post of importance in Wales. It is not right to boycott them because of their nationality. An amendment to make temporary arrangements for six months was carried by a large majority.
