**FREAKY FUDGE**  
1/2 cup breakfast cocoa  
1/2 cup brown sugar  
1 cup granulated sugar  
dash of salt  
1/2 cup water  
Combine cocoa, sugar and salt, add water and milk, and place over low flame. Stir constantly until sugar is dissolved and mixture boils. Continue cooking without stirring until a small amount of mixture forms in cold water (232 F.). Remove from fire. Add butter and vanilla. Cool to lukewarm (110 F.) then beat until mixture thickens and loses its gloss. Add nuts and pour at once into greased pan. When cold cut in separate squares. Makes 18 pieces.

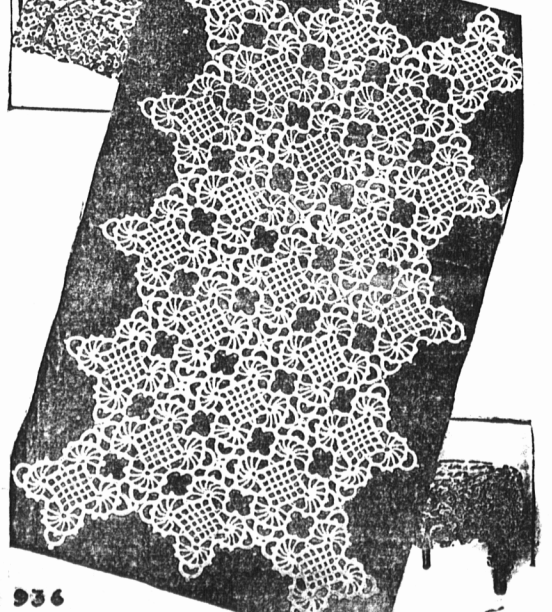

## APRICOT COBBLER

Two and one-half cups sliced apricots (or peaches), 2 tablespoons minute tapioca, 1-2 cup corn syrup, 1-4 teaspoon salt, 1-4 teaspoon cinnamon, 1/2 cup raisins, 1 tablespoon butter.

## BAKING POWDER BISCUIT DOUGH

Two cups flour, 4 teaspoons baking powder, 1-2 teaspoon salt, 4 tablespoons shortening, 3-4 cup milk. Slice the apricots into buttered shallow baking dish and add the tapioca to them and let stand 15 minutes. Pour over the corn syrup, salt and spices. Mix well. Dot top with butter. To make the dough sift the flour, baking powder and salt together. Run the shortening in with the fingertips, and add enough milk slowly to make a soft dough. Roll out to 1/4-inch thickness, prick and arrange over top of apricot mixture. Bake at 400 to 425 degrees F for about 30 minutes or until well browned. Other fruits that are "best" with this treatment are blackberries, cherries and rhubarb. If you can't borrow or steal any, Devonshire cream makes this one of those desserts that only superior beings deserve.
