S. S. LESSON.

MARCH 8.

JESUS BETRAYED. John 18. 1-14. Memory verses, 8-11.

GOLDEN TEXT. The son of man is betrayed into the hands of sinners.—Matt. 26. 45.

OUTLINE. 1. Jesus Betrayed, v. 1-5. 2. Jesus Defended, v. 6-11. 3. Jesus Captured, v. 12-14.

Time.—Near the middle of the night following Thursday, April 6, A. D. 30. Peace.—1. The Garden of Gethsemane. 2. The court of the high priest (probably).

LESSON HELPS 1-3. "These words"—The prayer as given in the preceding chapter. "Cedron"—A river torrent which ran through a ravine between Olivet and Mount Moriah.

"A garden"—Here, under the shade of the olive trees, Jesus walked and talked. It was a favorite place with Jesus and his disciples, and was well known to Judas. "A band of men and officers"—The multitude consisted of (1) a detachment of Roman soldiers, (2) the captains of the temple, (3) some Jewish officers and their servants with lanterns. It was still dark, but near the morning hour. Read Matt. 26. 48, 49. for additional particulars.

4. "Knowing all things"—The foreknowledge and grandeur of Jesus now shine forth. "Went forth"—He steps devoid of fear, for he was guilty of no wrong. "Whom seek ye"—A question asked not to find out, but to make his enemies confess their purpose.

5. "Of Nazareth"—Because that was his early home. The words were spoken with that calm dignity which became his character.

6-8. "Fell to the ground"—Something in the nature and spirit of Jesus overcame them. His noble nature rose far above theirs. "Let these go their way"—In that trying hour he thought of his disciples and was willing to give up himself that they might be spared.

9. That the saying might be fulfilled which he spake in chapter 17, 12, which see.

10. "Simon Peter"—His affectionate and impulsive nature now appears, but his act was a rash one and might have had serious consequences.

11. "The cup which my Father hath given me"—This was the cup of sacrifice given by the Father for a wise purpose and freely partaken of by Christ, even to the bitter dregs.

13. "To Annas first"—An important person of age and wisdom, and held in great honour by his title to the priesthood. This was a preliminary examination.

14. "Caiphas"—The high priest, who had already committed himself to the policy of condemnation. It is not right to unjustly condemn an innocent man to save others. A man may be willing to sacrifice himself to gain some noble end for others, but to force him so to do is not right.
