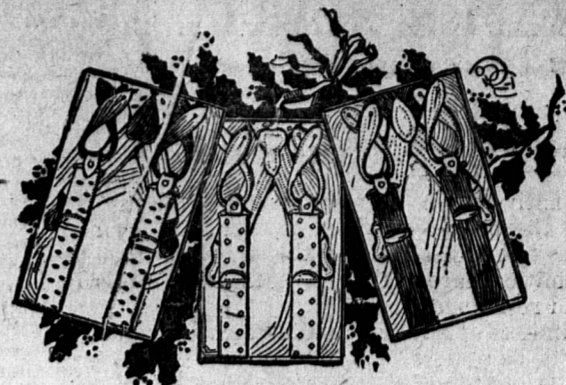

THE MINNIE J. DICKS WRECK.—The Sydney Post says that according to information received at North Sydney last evening by George A. Le Moine, the body of his adopted son, John Albert LeMoine, had been washed ashore on the island of St. Pierre. Young LeMoine, who was 20 years of age, was a member of the crew of the schooner Minnie J. Dicks, that foundered off St. Pierre two days ago. Until the receipt of the telegram at North Sydney nothing was heard of the crew on the ill-fated vessel, but it is believed that all hands were lost. The Minnie J. Dicks sailed from St. John's, Newfoundland, with its general cargo bound for Rose Blanche, Newfoundland. She was in command of her part owner, Capt. Malcolm Munro, of Bras d'Or, and nearly all the members of the crew were Cape Bretoners. Ripkroo Brothers in Sydney and Capt. Munro are the owners of the vessel, which was registered in Sydney.—The Minnie J. is well known in shipping circles here.
