IN MEMORIAM

SEYMOUR GORDON MacLENNAN

The death at his home Alexandria, P. E. I., September 2, 1943 of Seymour Gordon MacLennan at the age of 71 years, was learned by the people of Alexandria and surrounding communities with a feeling of sincere sympathy and sorrow in the loss of a life-long and outstanding neighbor and friend. The deceased was a son of the late Emily MacLennan and Annie Kelly MacLennan of Alexandria. He was a farmer and gardener classed as one that had made a great success in his calling. In his work as market gardener he made a legion of friends with his customers and patrons in the City of Charlottetown. Besides his great interest in farming and the building up of a home he was a sportsman of a high order. He was well known at the rifle range and took part in the provincial matches. But he was perhaps better known in the field of game birds. In his work of wing-shot and spent many happy hours hunting game birds, especially blue and red-winged quail. He liberally fed the first hungarian partridges at Alexandria, and was greatly interested in the ring-neck pheasant seeking to protect and conserve them, and in fact, a large flock found food and refuge on his farm during each winter season. The late Mr. MacLennan will be remembered by his many friends, neighbours and business acquaintances for his kind cheerful manner and his fine qualities of heart and mind. As a community man he lived a life noble true and secure. His fine religious spirit was shown in his many acts of kindness and brotherly love to all who at any time needed a helping hand, his principle in life was "If you can say no good about anyone, say no evil." But besides his life in the home and community, the church for him was his life. He was Senior Deacon of the Alexandria Baptist Church and for years was ever present at the church to attend the services and support the Church in every way. The Church like many others has lost one of its pillars of strength. He leaves to mourn his passing, his wife, formerly Ada Jane Judson, daughter of the late James G. Judson, a three sons, George, Harold and the youngest, Vernon all of Alexandria; also two daughters, the late Marie wife of Robert Carter, Milton, P. E. I., and Mary, teacher in West Kent School, Charlottetown. Miss Mary B. Judson, a sister-in-law, and another brother, also two sisters, viz Sarah (wife of late Benjamin Wood, Alexandria) and Maria, predeceased him. The funeral was held on Friday, September 10th, with a short service at the home of J. W. Huxter of River John, N. S., a former pastor of the Alexandria Church led the services assisted by Rev. D. K. Ross, of Pownall United Church. The following is the order of the funeral service in Alexandria Baptist Church: Scripture Reading and Prayer by Rev. D. K. Ross. Sermon from the text Job, Chap. 5, verse 26. One hymn was sung to the grave in a full age like as a shock of corn cometh in his season, by the Rev. J. W. Huxter. The following hymns were sung—"Blest Be The Tie That Binds," "Safe In The Arms of Jesus," "Sweet Bye And Bye," "Nearer My God To Thee." Mrs. Batrice Judson and Mrs. Nathaniel MacKinnon sang "The City of Gold." (This was a favorite hymn of the departed and of his mother and had also been sung at her funeral.) Miss Pearl Jones was the organist. Prayer and Benediction by the Rev. Mr. Huxter. Following the service the remains were interred in the Alexandria Cemetery. Pall bearers—Messrs. W. Chester S. MacLure, Earl Jenkins, Wellington MacNevin, Samuel Cousins, M. W. Wood, Robert Jones. AVOID GARDEN ACCIDENTS BY CARE OF TOOLS

With thousands of novice gardeners working Victory gardens this year for the first time, records of the National Safety Council provide excellent data on the most common garden accidents and how to avoid them. Most common error is to leave rakes, hoes, pruners, and other tools where they may be stepped on or tripped over. Gardeners using a variety of tools should keep them in one place with tines or blades face down, and when stored they should be hung on a wall rather than propped against it. When using axes, mattocks, or other sharp tools, make sure the head is tight on the handle and that no one is in range of the swing. Many garden accidents are caused by splintered tool handles, and abrasions caused by splinters can be serious, especially when the hands are gny after planting or weeding. Hands should be washed frequently with a good deodorizing health soap, and worn handles should be replaced or smoothed with sandpaper and taped.
