CONSERVATIVE SPECULATION

In Regard to Hon. A. G. Blair's Resignation of Office Was Predicted by Tarte—Difference With Laurier—Held to be a Blow to the Government—Blair's Future Course.

OTTAWA, July 13—Hon. A. G. Blair placed his resignation in the hands of the Governor-General to-day. This is the startling but not unexpected announcement made here tonight.

Other matters have helped to add to Blair's chagrin. His railway commission bill was treated with scant courtesy, and every little criticism of the affairs of the Intercolonial was hailed with delight by the Government.

Blair's resignation will mean an extensive shuffle in the Cabinet, and Sutherland will probably succeed him. Prefontaine, in this case, will go to the Public Works department, and Emmerson will be taken into the cabinet as minister of marine and fisheries.
