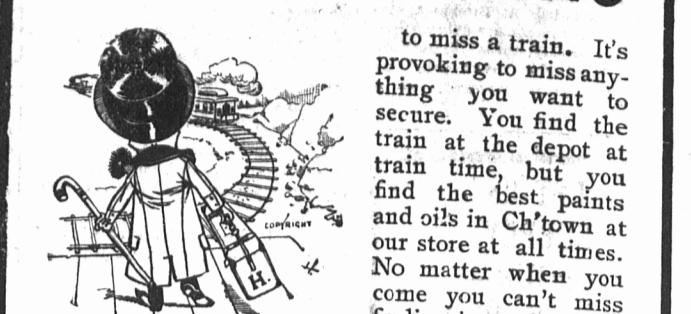
BIG DAMAGE TO THE RAILWAY STATION
