SERVIAN KING WANTS PEACE

BELGRADE, November 5.—King Peter presided at the cabinet meetings to consider urgent advice from Great Britain, France, Russia and Italy to check the popular war clamor. Subsequently the government published a declaration affirming that Serbia does not intend to go to war or to provoke Austria. It says that the government has done its utmost to protect Austrian interests. It has repressed the anti-Austrian demonstrations, although Austria mobilized troops on the Servian frontier, and prevented not only material of war, but merchandise entering the country. It adds that Serbia awaits a conference hopefully, relying upon her friends to advocate her just cause.
