Luther's Wedding Ring Located

LONDON, Nov. 28.—The London Library is adding to its Luther Exhibition a ring which appears to be Martin Luther's wedding ring. The ring forms an entire cross, on which is a figure of the Saviour, over whose head a large ruby is set, serving as a nimbus. Above, on a label, are the letters, I. N. R. I., and emblems of the Crucifixion are continued round the ring. On the inside is engraved the inscription "P. Martino Luthero, Catharina Borgo, 13 Jan. 1525," the date of Luther's marriage.

The ring, which was recently purchased in Vienna, appears to agree exactly with one exhibited by the late Mr. J. R. Planché, on behalf of Mr. Charles Beauchamp in London, in 1854, which is described in the Proceedings of the Archaeological Association, Vol. X., 1854-5.

Whether the two rings are the one and the same it is impossible to say.

Close-fitting HATS TO FIT THE COIFFURE

PARIS, Nov. 28.—To fit the new close-fitting coiffure of today there is the new close-fitting hat. Whether the chapeau is very wide or very small, it is now drawn on from the back so that the knot at the nape of the neck goes up into the crown of the hat, the hat is then pulled low over the eyes and worn without pins.

PARIS, Nov. 28.—Many of the evening gowns to-day are being made on extremely simple lines, the back showing not waistline at all. There is a flower or two in front as a pretense of girle, but the back fills in an unbroken sweep from neck to hem giving the new and much sought effect of being hung from the neck.

It was a dark blue goerette, cut on straight Grecian lines, and powdered all over with brilliant tiny stars in a winter sky. A knotted silver cord for a girle was the only ornament.

Mushroom Exhibition

PARIS, Nov. 28.—For the first time since the outbreak of the world war, the custom of holding a comparative exhibition of edible and poisonous mushrooms has been revived at the Museum of Natural History, Paris.

M. Mangin, a director of the institution has gathered together 400 different species, varying in size from a pinhead, to giants weighing over two pounds. The mushrooms will be labelled and placed in the exhibit in sections according to their food value and poison danger.

According to M. Mangin, there are only three or four really dangerous mushrooms, chiefly Phalloid Amanites and Clitellas, the least particle of which, if eaten, means death.
