His last appointment was that of captain of the Corps of Gentlemen-at-Arms, the famous royal bodyguard which celebrated its 400th anniversary last year.

A HATER OF CONNECTICUT.

A grudge against Connecticut seems to have been the ruling passion, strong in death, of Lewis Morris, of Morrisania, who died in 1816. Part of the will Governor Morris made is printed in Case and Comment, as follows: "My desire is, that nothing be mentioned about me, not so much as a single line in a News Paper, to tell the World I am dead; it is my wish that my son Governor Morris may have the best Education that it be had in England or America, but my Express Will and Directions are, that he never be sent for that purpose to the Colony of Connecticut, lest he should imbibe in his Youth the false and cunning opinions incident to the People of that Country, which is so interwoven in their constitutions, that all their art cannot disguise it from the World. Tho' many of them under the Sanctified Garb of Religion have endeavored to impose themselves on the World for Honest Men."

THE FIRST RINGS.

In the tombs of ancient Egypt the earliest rings known to history are found. The first and more common are of pure gold and of simple design, but very massive, while the name of the owner is deeply cut on an oblong gold bezel. The lower classes had rings of silver, glass, bronze or even clay with a glazed surface, the inscriptions on which have been very often impressed while the clay was still moist. Other rings have been found made of ivory, cornelian and amber. Under the later dynasties a seal was used in London as to allow it to revolve. The rings were greatly in favor among the Greeks and were set as a rule with engraved gems. In Sparta a curious law was passed which forbade the use of any metal other than iron in their composition, which was so strictly enforced that the application of the letter of Mr. P. A.
