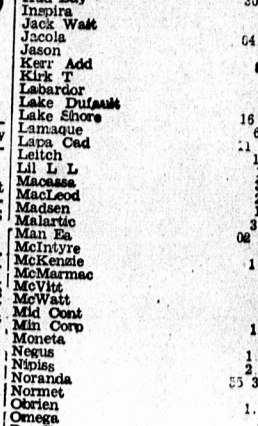

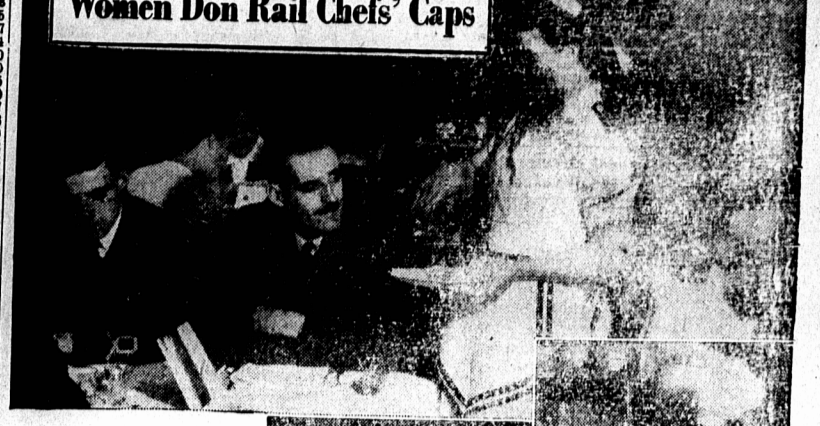
Women Don Rail Chefs' Caps

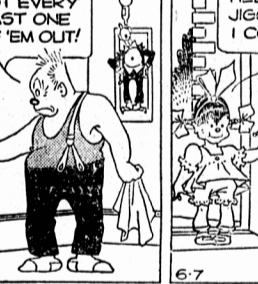

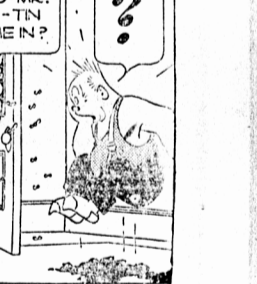
