GREETED THE POPULAR PRINCE

QUEBEC, July 27.—One of the most interesting of the Prince of Wales' experiences during his present visit to Canada was today, when he visited the quaint old village of St. Joachim, where he was entertained by the reverend gentlemen at the seminary. His Royal Highness was taken over ground hallowed at the very cradle of Canadian history, where Champlain founded his first farm and where the sites of ancient forts mark the scenes of many a fierce conflict under the shadow of the high rock of Cape Tourment, while the buildings at the chateau are among the oldest in the country dating back to 1779, since which time they have been secured as a summer resort for the secular priests connected with Laval.

COMMANDER SPAIN ON WAY TO QUEBEC

ST. JOHN, July 27.—Commander Spain, commissioner of wrecks and pilotage, arrived in the city yesterday in company with his wife en route to Quebec from Sydney. The commander has no special business in the city. He has been spending a few days at Sydney in connection with the investigation into the collision between the ship Kildes and the ferry-boat Scotia at that town a short time ago. The investigation had not been completed when Mr. Spain left and he did not care to disclose any information regarding the outcome until it was completed. Several cases of importance are awaiting him at Quebec and Montreal.

FARMING BY MERE PUSH OF BUTTON

NEW YORK, July 28.—Thomas W. Lee, until about two years ago general passenger agent of the Delaware, Lackawanna and Western railroad, with headquarters in New York, is the first man in the world to farm by electricity. Mr. Lee owns the Bungalow, a tract of more than 3000 acres in the vicinity of Idaho Falls. All that Tom Lee has to do now when he wishes to farm is to push a button. Electricity does the rest. The ground in the Bungalow was broken for cultivation two years ago. The first season it returned a profit on gain. It is fenced, has fine buildings, machinery and stock, and is managed by a man to whom system is as necessary as breath.

SCENES AT OLD QUEBEC

QUEBEC, July 27.—Gorgeous in conception and magnificent in execution was the naval display given by the British fleet tonight. Nothing like was ever seen in Quebec before.

Intense enthusiasm was aroused among the thousands of spectators on shore and in the harbor. It was among the best of the many spectacular events of the celebration and to those from inland points particularly it was a revelation. Nova Scotia's gift to the Princess of Wales was formally presented to the Prince today. This fur coat, presented to Her Royal Highness by the people of the Eastern Province, was presented by Lieutenant Governor Fraser, Premier Murray and Hon. W. S. Fielding, and the Prince expressed his kindest thanks to the people of Nova Scotia for the gift.

A POLICEMAN ARRESTED.

NEW YORK, July 28.—Policeman David Shellard was today arrested in connection with the murder of Barbara Reig, the young woman shot in Living Park, Williamsburg. According to a statement by Deputy Commissioner Woods, Shellard confessed that he was with the girl when she took his revolver and shot herself in the head.

The girl's body was found in a summer-house in Irving Park yesterday and was identified by her mother and brother, who had seen photographs of the dead girl in the papers.

EXPERIMENTING WITH WHEY BUTTER.

OTTAWA, July 28.—In the Dairy Department of the Ontario Agricultural College, this season, experiments are being conducted each week in the manufacture of whey butter. Sometimes they are able to make a very nice quality of butter, and other times the quality is quite inferior. One sample of whey butter, scored a fortnight since, would class very well with the best dairy butter. They are also testing its keeping quality, but, up to the present, Prof. Dean informs us they have no very definite data on this experiment.
